The Kent County Sheriff's Office is scheduled for an on-site assessment as part of a program to achieve reaccreditation by verifying it meets professional standards. The Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies, (CALEA) requires agencies to comply with state-of-the-art standards in four basic areas: policy and procedures, management, operations and support services.

As part of this assessment process, agency employees and members of the community are invited to attend a public information session to offer comments. Comments are limited to 10 minutes and must address the agency's ability to comply with CALEA's standards.
